Their new Home Gadgets Project is a new way to offer support using smart technology and gadgets.

This is a pilot project and during the pilot there is no charge for the loan of equipment, please note we cannot support any item that has ongoing costs. Where equipment requires wi-fi this will need to already be in place and cannot be provided by the project.



To be eligible, you must:

- ♥ live in one of the seven district council areas of Leicestershire: Blaby, Charnwood, Harborough, Hinckley and Bosworth, Melton, North West Leicestershire, Oadby and Wigston
- ♥ be living with dementia, or awaiting diagnosis
- ♥ have a physical, mental or neurological vulnerability
- ♥ agree to provide feedback in exchange for the loan of equipment

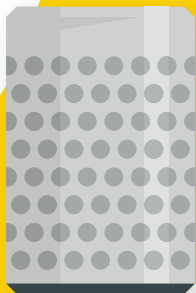

Examples of equipment the project can provide:



- **A digital calendar clock displaying the date and month**

This gadget was provided to a lady living with dementia who was pacing the house, trying to find the time and has since really benefited from it.



- **Smart hub**

A smart hub has multiple functions to help aid memory problems, including setting an alarm for reminders, ordering shopping, providing a weather update and much more.



- **Wireless doorbell**

Has reduced isolation for lady who was hard of hearing, she now hears visitors at the door and can move it from room to room as she moves around house.



- **Pill dispenser**

A pill dispenser can support the taking of medication.



- **Multi opener**

Has meant I no longer have to wait for carers and family to call to open things, restoring a feeling of independence.
